These 104 names are transcribed from two faded, worn, and in places difficult to read cardboard sheets, each headed "Roll of Service", which have survived amongst the records of St. Mary's Church, Chaddesden, and provide a contemporaneous record of those church members who served in the forces during the Second World War. When the two sheets were first drawn up the names were evidently added as and when information came to hand, but for clarity they are combined here in a single alphabetical sequence. Approximately one-third of the original entries specify in which branch of the forces an individual served and these details are given in brackets after the relevant name. Emphasising the dangers of war-time service, some of the original entries are marked in a later hand as "Missing in action", "Prisoner", or "Killed", but these comments have not been included here. It is possible that other similar sheets providing further names were made, but only the two described above are now known to exist. (Details reproduced by kind permission of St. Mary's Church)
